



Collective Worship Planner- Spring Term 2 2023/24

Notes

- The guiding principles of all acts of worship should be to make them ***Inclusive – Invitational - Inspiring***
- All acts of worship should follow the four-fold structure of: ***Gather – Engage – Respond – Send***
- Monday worship must introduce the theme and hymn/song of the week.
- Each week is highlighted with the liturgical colour. The colour of cloth on the table and in the classroom should correspond with this. The liturgical colour is also displayed on the PowerPoint slide in Worship.
- Tues class worship focus upon British Values/Protected Characteristics.
- Thursday celebration worship during which all parents/cares are welcome.
- Friday class worship focus upon theme/value of the week.
- Whole school worship to begin at 3:00 prompt and end 3:25 prompt. (Class worship has no time limit)

Gather

- Pupils to enter hall/class worship to reflection music and a question/object/picture which stimulates reflection.
- All whole school worship to begin with a welcome and lighting the candle followed by the Lord's Prayer and the school values (call and response), vision statement. The value of the term and Bible verse also to be shared.
- All class-based worship to begin with a welcome followed by prayer. Introduce British Value/Protected Char/values etc. End with reflection.
- Gather Post It Note thoughts to add to class values and/or British Value display
- Children to write a request to light the candle (must be linked to the theme of the week as displayed in class/hall)

Engage

- All whole school worship (Mon/Weds/Friday) to include story/link to bible verse/parable etc (Friday recap British Value/Protected Characteristic).
- All pupils and staff expected to join in with hymn during whole school worship. This is to be reminded during class worship.

Respond

- All worship should give children the opportunity for reflection. This could be a question/quotation/bible /picture stimulus/object.

Send

- Pupils and staff to share 'The Goodbye message' before being dismissed.

Value of the Term - Truth

'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the father except through me.'
John 14:6



Definition: Truth matters. As individuals, being truthful means that we can grow and mature, learning from our mistakes. For society, truthfulness makes social bonds, and lying breaks them. If you doubt this, consider what happens when you find out that someone has lied to you. You feel less inclined to trust them next time, and less inclined to trust other people more generally. Truthfulness is important because God is the God of truth

Questions: What does it mean to be truthful? Is telling the truth always the right thing to do? Is being truthful always easy? What are the consequences of not being truthful?

Key Bible Character – Zaccheaus - Zaccheaus had a life changing encounter with Jesus. As a tax collector he was dishonest and unpopular. After Jesus visited his house, he changed. He pledged to give away half of what he had. In addition, he stated he would surrender everything he had ever stolen. He acknowledged he had made many mistakes in the past. He became truthful in his interactions with others.

Key Bible verse: Tell the truth to each other.' Zechariah 8.16
