

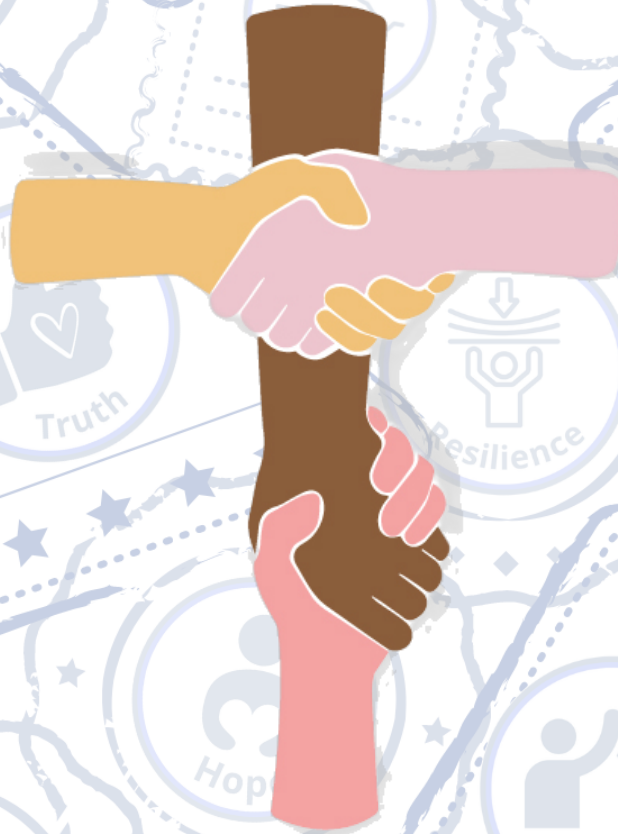

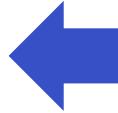

INTRODUCING OUR SCHOOL VISION

MATTHEW 19:26



You might see or hear these words around school... it's part of our **SCHOOL VISION**. A vision is a big dream shared by a community of people.

WHERE DOES IT COME FROM?

Our school vision comes from the Bible. The Bible tells us about things that Jesus said and did. Jesus talked to people about God, how much God loves them, and how God wants them to live.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

Jesus told his friends that if they trust God, even the things that seem impossible can be done! Jesus wants us to do the same - if we trust God and ask Him for help, we can do the impossible!

INTRODUCING OUR SCHOOL VALUES

WHAT ARE SCHOOL VALUES?

Our set of 6 school values also come from the Bible. They help everyone in our school community (children and grown-ups) make good choices about how to behave and treat each other.

THESE VALUES ARE A BIG PART OF OUR SCHOOL LIFE!

We look at how Jesus and others in the Bible show these values.

We explore them during Collective Worship and in our classrooms.

We can live these values when we are in the playground, on school trips, taking part in sports and other events.

When we all work together to show our school values, Pytchley is a happier and safer place for everyone!

SCHOOL VALUES

We have **6** school values. We try to show all of the values all year round, but we focus on one value each half term:

AUTUMN TERM

Sept - Oct half term



Half term - Christmas



SPRING TERM

Jan - Feb half term



Half term - Easter



SUMMER TERM

Easter - May half term



Half term - Summer break

SPRING TERM 2 VALUE TRUTH

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

TRUTH is about trying to always speak and act honestly and sincerely. It means being your true self, and not telling lies or acting in a fake way.

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT IT?

In the Bible, the word 'truth' appears 333 times! Jesus describes himself by saying that He is '...the way, the truth and the life'. Jesus meant that his way of living was the very best way, because it's the way that God wants us to live.

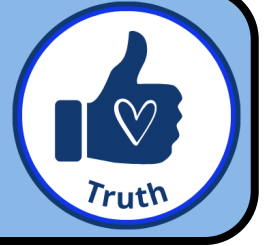
The VALUES SPOTTER box is for you to record when you have seen someone else showing this value at home!

RESILIENCE means not giving up means not giving up when things get hard, keeping going, and finding ways to bounce back.

Jesus told a story about a woman who was being treated badly. She wanted a judge to make sure she was treated fairly. The judge kept sending her away, but the woman came back again and again. The judge helped her in the end because she never gave up asking for help!

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

HOPE is like a little spark inside you that makes you feel positive and excited about the future. It's believing that good things can happen, even when things seem tough.



WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT IT?



The Bible talks about hope a lot! King David wrote a beautiful song (or psalm) about having hope in God, and trusting in God's love and care, even when everything seems to be going wrong. Christians often talk about 'putting their hope in Jesus' for exactly the same reason.

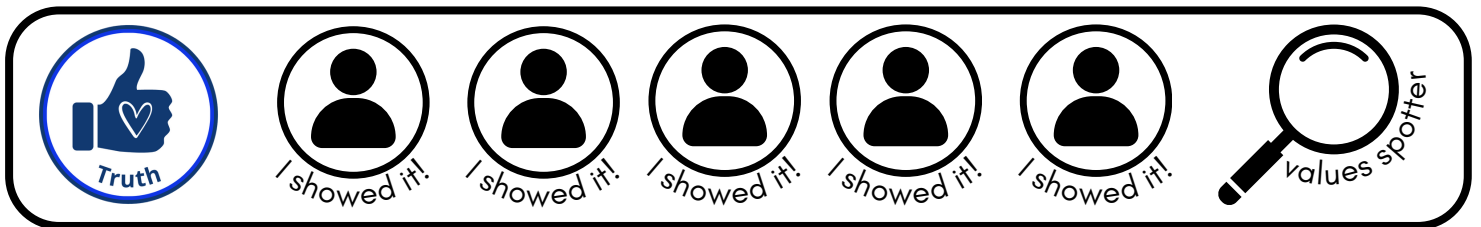

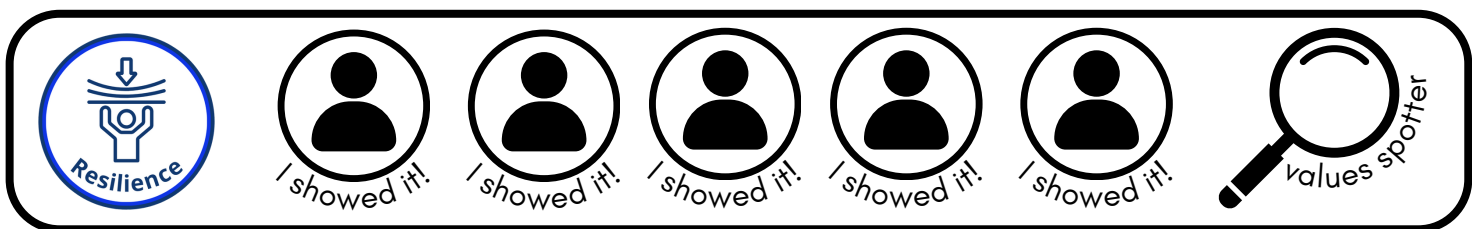
