In class we are continuing to do out daily reading pledge every day after lunch where we enjoy a story together as a class. Year 1 children will continue to learn the phase 5 phonics sounds daily, following the scheme Little Wandle. Each child will read in their shared reading groups, within class and they will focus on decoding, expression and comprehension during those sessions. The children's reading books will still be changed on **Mondays and Fridays** (all children now have updated books with the correct level according to recent assessments).

Expectations

Returning to school after a break always means getting back into a routine, we expect that the children will soon settle back into this. Arriving on time and ready in the **correct uniform** is essential for children to feel part of the community.

As always, we expect the children to follow our core school values of respect, responsibility, resilience, truth, hope and friendship.
