We have worked so hard in our Maths lessons, learning how to multiply 2, 3 and 4 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers.


Our literacy lessons have been focussed on completing our unit on explanations texts. We have linked this with our Science work and written explanations about how the blood is circulated round our bodies.


