Shining in the dark

Literacy

Through 'Talk 4 Writing' we will share stories that focus on:

- Rhyme and repeated phrases.
- Traditional story language – 'Once upon a time' and 'happily ever after'.
- Making predictions and ordering events.

We will also work hard to:

- Recognising and writing our own name.
- Begin to recognise and form letter sounds.
- Begin to build and blend CV and CVC words.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be exploring:

- Role-play experiences including; Chinese takeaway, elf's workshop and home corner.
- Which role they might want to play and learning how to negotiate, be patient and solve conflicts.
- Movement and listening games that use different sounds for different movements.

Religious Education

The topic for this term will be:

UC: Why do Christians perform Nativity plays at Christmas?

Physical Development

We will be developing:

- Our awareness of our personal space and how to negotiate space in the different learning areas.
- Our movement on a range of surfaces to feel, move and balance on, such as grass, earth and bark chippings.
- Our core strength and stability needed to support their small motor skills.

Communication and Language

We will focus on:

- Words relating to light and dark, celebrations and traditions.
- Taking part in discussions as a small group or class.
- Making links between listening and learning.
- Asking and answering questions involving who, when, where and explaining our answers.

Mathematics

In Maths we will be focussing on the five principles of counting:

1. 1:1 Principle
2. Stable Order Principle
3. Cardinal Principle
4. Abstraction Principle
5. Order Irrelevance Principle

We will be exploring these by:

- Matching, sorting and comparing amounts.
- Looking at how amounts up to 5 can be represented, compared and the composition of numbers.
- Exploring patterns, by continuing, making our own and finding errors.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about:

- Fireworks night.
- Diwali
- Christmas and family celebrations.
- Sources of light and dark.
- People that have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.
- The effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be:

- Exploring our friendship groups and continuing to build strong relationships.
- Jigsaw PHSE.
- Look for ways to solve problems in our play, asking for help when needed.
- Understanding and beginning to manage our feelings.
